AMENDMENTS TO THE
DECLARATION OF CONDOMINIUM OWNERSHIP FOR
MACINTOSH FARMS CONDOMINIUM NO. 1

WHEREAS, the Declaration of Condominium Ownership for MacIntosh Farms Condominium No. 1 (the "Declaration") and the Bylaws of MacIntosh Farms Condominium No. 1 Owners' Association (the "Bylaws"), Exhibit "B" to the Declaration, were recorded at Cuyahoga County Records Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., and

WHEREAS, Section 5311.05(E)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, as amended on July 20, 2004, authorizes the Board of Directors, without a vote of the Owners, to amend the Declaration "to bring the Declaration in compliance with this Chapter," and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors approved the following matters to be modified (the "Amendments") in order to bring the Declaration into compliance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5311, and

WHEREAS, the proceedings necessary to amend the Declaration and Bylaws as permitted by Chapter 5311 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Declaration of Condominium Ownership for MacIntosh Farms Condominium No. 1 have in all respects been complied with.

NOW THEREFORE, the Declaration of Condominium Ownership for MacIntosh Farms Condominium No. 1 is hereby amended by the Board of Directors as follows:

- (1) All references in the Declaration and Bylaws to the term "Common Areas" or "Common Areas and Facilities" shall be replaced with the term "Common Elements."
- (2) All references in the Declaration and Bylaws to the term "Limited Common Areas" or "Limited Common Areas and Facilities" shall be replaced with the term "Limited Common Elements."
- (3) All references in the Declaration and Bylaws to the term "Board of Managers" shall be replaced with the term "Board of Directors."
- (4) All references in the Declaration and Bylaws to the term "Fines" shall be replaced with the term "Enforcement Assessments."
- (5) **DELETE DECLARATION ARTICLE IV, SECTION (C), entitled "Service of Process,"** in its entirety. Said deletion is to be made on Page 19 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq.

INSERT a new DECLARATION ARTICLE IV, SECTION (C), entitled "Service of Process." Said addition, to be made on Page 19 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

(C) Service of Process. The person to receive service of process for the Association shall be as designated by the Board. This designation will be accomplished by filing with the Ohio Secretary of State the required statutory agent designation form.

(6) INSERT a new SECTION (E), entitled "Enforcement Assessments," to the end of DECLARATION ARTICLE X. Said new addition, to be added on Page 30 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

(E) Enforcement Assessments. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.081(B)(12), the Board shall have the authority to impose interest and administrative late fees for the late payment of Assessments; impose returned check charges; and, in accordance with the procedure outlined in Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.081(C)(1), impose reasonable enforcement Assessments for violations of the Declaration, the Bylaws, and the rules of the Association, and reasonable charges for damage to the Common Elements.

(7) INSERT a new 2nd PARAGRAPH to the end of DECLARATION ARTICLE V, SECTION (D), entitled "Lien of Association." Said new addition, to be added on Page 20 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.18(A)(1)(b), the Association has a lien upon each Unit's ownership interest for any unpaid interest, administrative late fees, enforcement Assessments, and collection costs, attorney's fees, and paralegal fees.

(8) INSERT a new 2nd PARAGRAPH to the end of DECLARATION ARTICLE XVI, SECTION (B), entitled "Unit Owner's Right to Lease Unit." Said new addition, to be added on Page 39 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.19(B), the Association may initiate eviction proceedings, pursuant to Chapters 5321 and 1923 of the Revised Code, to evict a tenant. The action shall be brought by the Association, as the Unit Owner's Agent, in the name of the Unit Owner.

In addition to any procedures required by Chapters 5321 and 1923 of the Revised Code, the Association shall give the Unit Owner at least ten days written notice of the intended eviction action. The costs of any eviction action, including reasonable attorney's fees, shall be charged to the Unit Owner and shall be the subject of a special Assessment against the offending Unit and made a lien against that Unit.

(9) INSERT a new 2nd PARAGRAPH to the end of DECLARATION ARTICLE V, SECTION (A), entitled "General." Said new addition, to be added on Page 19 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.18(A)(2), the Association shall credit payments made by a Unit Owner in the following order of priority:

- (1) First, to interest owed to the Association;
- (2) Second, to administrative late fees owed to the Association;
- (3) Third, to collection costs, attorney's fees, and paralegal fees incurred by the Association; and
- (4) Fourth, to the principal amounts the Unit Owner owes to the Association for the common expenses or enforcement Assessments chargeable against the Unit.

(10) INSERT a new 2nd PARAGRAPH to the end of BYLAWS ARTICLE IV, SECTION 4, entitled "Special Services." Said new addition, to be added on Page 14 of the Bylaws, Exhibit "B" of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.081(B)(15), the Board may impose reasonable charges to the Unit Owner for providing copies of the Declaration, Bylaws or amendments thereto as well as reasonable charges for the handling of re-financing and/or resale documentation, and/or statements of unpaid Assessments.

(11) INSERT a new SECTION (N) to DECLARATION ARTICLE VII. Said new addition, to be added on Page 28 of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

(N) In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.09(A)(2) and (3), each Unit Owner shall, within thirty (30) days of the recording of this Amendment or within thirty (30) days of title transferring to the Unit Owner,

provide to the Association the Unit Owner's and/or all occupants' names, home and business mailing addresses, home and business telephone numbers, and the name, business address and business telephone number of any person who manages the Unit as an agent of that Owner. Any change in the information shall be provided to the Board, in writing, within thirty (30) days of said change.

(12) INSERT a new 2nd SENTENCE to the end of BYLAWS ARTICLE II, SECTION 7, entitled "Regular Meetings." Said new addition, to be added on Page 7 of the Bylaws, Exhibit "B" of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., and as amended at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 97-03616, Page 39 et seq., is as follows:

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.08(A)(4)(a), any Board meeting may be held in person or by any method of communication, including electronic or telephonic communication, provided that each Board member can hear, participate and respond to every other Board member.

(13) INSERT a new SENTENCE to the end of BYLAWS ARTICLE V, SECTION 2, entitled "Preparation of Estimated Budget." Said new addition, to be added on Page 15 of the Bylaws, Exhibit "B" of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., is as follows:

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.21, in the alternative, if the Association has collected a Common Surplus at the end of any fiscal year, the Board may determine that such amount will be applied toward reserves.

(14) INSERT a new PARAGRAPH (I) to BYLAWS ARTICLE II, SECTION 10, entitled "Powers and Duties," and INSERT new SUBPARAGRAPHS (1), (2), (3) and (4), thereafter. Said new additions to be added on Page 8 of the Bylaws, Exhibit "B" of the Declaration, as recorded at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 86-4892, Page 7 et seq., and as amended at Cuyahoga County Records, Volume 97-03616, Page 36 et seq is as follows:

(I) In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5311.081(B), in addition to all other powers enumerated herein, the Board may exercise all powers of the Association, including the power to do the following:

(1) Commence, defend, intervene in, settle, or compromise any civil, criminal, or administrative action or proceeding that is in the name of, or threatened against, the Association, the Board, or the Condominium

Property, or that involves two or more Unit Owners and relates to matters affecting the Condominium Property;

(2) Grant leases, licenses, and concessions through or over the Common Elements;

(3) Impose and collect fees or other charges for the use, rental, or operation of the Common Elements or for services provided to Unit Owners;

(4) Invest excess funds in investments that meet standards for fiduciary investments under Ohio law.

Any conflict between the above provisions and any other provisions of the Declaration and Bylaws shall be interpreted in favor of the above amendments. Upon the recording of these amendments, only Unit Owners of record at the time of such filing shall have standing to contest the validity of these amendments, whether on procedural, substantive or any other grounds, provided further that any such challenge shall be brought in the court of common pleas within one year of the recording of the amendments.
